**Sub:- National Electoral Roll Purification and Authentication Programme (NERPAP) by Election Commission of India - Field Visit by the Officials appointed as Booth Level Officers (BLOs) - Treating the day as duty - Instructions Issued - Regarding.**

The Election Commission of India has launched National Electoral Roll Purification and Authentication Programme (NERPAP), a comprehensive National Programme with an objective of bringing a totally error free and authenticated electoral roll by eliminating duplicate entries, records of dead electors and by seeding Aadhar number against each electors in the roll.

Election Department have now requested the Government to issue necessary instructions to all Heads of Departments in the state to sanction duty leave for at least 4 days to the officials appointed as Booth Level Officers (BLOs) during the period from 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2015 to 5<sup>th</sup> May 2015 for the preparatory works including the house visits, collection of Aadhar number, collection of existing details of the electors etc., in connection with this programme based on the certificate of duty issued by the Electoral Registration Officers (Tahsildars).

Government have examined the matter in detail and hereby instruct all Heads of Departments to treat 4 days during the period from 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2015 to 5<sup>th</sup> May 2015 as duty in respect of the officials appointed by Election Commission as Booth Level Officers (BLOs) for their preparatory works in connection with the National Electoral Roll Purification and Authentication Programme (NERPAP) on the basis of the certificate of duty issued by the Electoral Registration Officers (Tahsildars).
