**Who is an Enlightened Voter?** This is a floor game that can be played by 3 to 6 players at a time. To start the game, players should spread the game on a floor with even surface. The game requires a facilitator. Players should decide amongst themselves as to who will be the game facilitator. Facilitator should read the instructions aloud carefully and explain to the players. The players mutually decide the order in which they will take turns to play.

**Instructions for playing** - All the players stand in a line at 'Start'. The facilitator stands with back towards the game and calls out any number from 1 to 6. The first player moves as many steps as the number called out by the facilitator. If the player arrives at the base of a ladder, the player reads aloud the statement and moves up to the top of the ladder. In case a player arrives at the mouth of a snake, the player reads the statement and goes down to the tail of the snake. The facilitator conducts a discussion related to each statement with all the players and bystanders.
