NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the President of India has, by notification issued under sub-section (2) of Section 14 of the Representation of People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) and published in the Gazette of India on the 28th March 2019 (Thursday), been pleased to call upon each of the parliamentary constituencies, specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, in the States or Union Territories mentioned in column (1), of the Schedule to elect members to the House of the People, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder;

- 2. Now, Therefore, in pursuance of Sections 30 and 56 of the said Act, the Election Commission of India hereby—
- (A) Appoints, with respect to the said election, from each of the parliamentary constituencies specified in the said Schedule,
 - (a) the 4th April, 2019 (Thursday), as the last date for making nominations;
 - (b) the 5th April, 2019 (Friday), as the date for scrutiny of nominations;
 - (c) the 8th April, 2019 (Monday), as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures:
- (d) the date specified in column (3) of the SCHEDULE below, as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken in the parliamentary constituencies, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said Schedule; and
- (e) the 27th May, 2019 (Monday), as the date before which the election shall be completed in all the above mentioned parliamentary constituencies; and
- (B) Fixes the hours specified in column (4) of the said Schedule, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in the constituencies, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said Schedule, on the date specified against such constituency in column (3) thereof, for the above election.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 166 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Government of Kerala hereby direct that the powers conferred and duties imposed on the Government, by provisions of Sections 160 to 165 of the said Act, shall be exercised and discharged by the Director General of Police, all Additional Directors General of Police, all Inspectors General of Police, all Deputy Inspectors General of Police, Commissioners of Police, Superintendents of Police and District Collectors, Additional District Magistrates and Sub Divisional Magistrates involved in election duties in any manner within their respective jurisdiction till 27-5-2019.
